



COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

FUNDACIÓN PARA EL FUTURO DE COLOMBIA

AND

THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

USC INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY

The Fundación para el Futuro de Colombia (COLFUTURO) and USC International Academy share an interest in strengthening bilateral cooperation in the field of education between Colombia and The United States of America, promoting stronger ties between the two institutions to increase the administrative support and guidance available for English language studies of Colombian students.

The purpose of this agreement is to foster cooperation and enhance the links between the two institutions through the provision of shared administrative support for talented students admitted to the COLFUTURO Language Program (LP) at the USC International Academy held at University of Southern California campus in Los Angeles, CA, USA.

The mutual cooperation will operate as follows:

- 1. Colombian students interested in learning or improving their English languages skills will seek admission to COLFUTURO Language Program and then to the English programs offered by USC International Academy, following the normal application procedures and meeting all the standard admission requirements established by the USC International Academy.
- 2. Students admitted to the Language Program of COLFUTURO are responsible for the attainment of financial resources to cover their programs.
- 3. COLFUTURO will receive the students' payments in three different instalments and then send by international wire the total cost of their program (one payment in full) directly to the USC International Academy account which has been previously established. COLFUTURO will pay on the students' behalf before their programs start. Some students may decide to pay directly to USC International Academy other costs such as accommodation or meals plans.
- 4. USC International Academy will directly invoice COLFUTURO for each of the students admitted to the USC International Academy. The invoices would be individual for each of our students and would have a breakdown for every item.
- 5. USC International Academy will provide a partial scholarship of 10% in the value of tuition for Undergraduate, Master's Preparation and Pre-Master's Programs and 15% in the value of tuition for Intensive English Programs at USC International Academy to every student sent by the Language Program of COLFUTURO. This benefit would be maintained or extended for the time the student decides to study at USC International Academy.

- 6. USC International Academy will offer one (1) full tuition scholarship of one semester to either Prep Programs or Intensive English Program (Academic semester) for every 10 or 20 students that COLFUTURO as sent in the previous terms to one of the Prep Programs or Intensive English Program (Academic semester) respectively.
- COLFUTURO will provide administrative support and guidance to the students with their admissions and visa processes. COLFUTURO will promote USC International Academy programs and the benefits agreed by this mutual cooperation.
- 8. Each institution will designate a coordinator to implement and monitor this agreement. In particular, the designated coordinators will be responsible for ensuring that:
 - USC International Academy and COLFUTURO provide prospective Colombian Language Program students with information on their programs of interest and guidance on how to apply to USC International Academy.
 - USC International Academy provides COLFUTURO with all the relevant promotional materials and brochures on the different programs offered by USC International Academy to encourage interest among prospective Colombian students.
 - c. USC International Academy provides all Colombian students admitted to their English language programs information on the Language Program of COLFUTURO and encourages these students to contact and submit an application to COLFUTURO.
 - d. COLFUTURO informs the USC International Academy of successful candidates by sending the list of Colombian students admitted to Language Program of COLFUTURO.
 - e. Both institutions have the obligation to inform the other party of any change in the designated coordinator or signatory in charge of this agreement.

This agreement shall remain in force from the date of signature by the designated representatives of each party and may be reviewed or renegotiated at the request of either party. Either party may terminate the agreement by providing at least thirty days' prior written notice to the other party.
