



COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

FUNDACIÓN PARA EL FUTURO DE COLOMBIA

AND

DEAKIN UNIVERSITY

The Fundación para el Futuro de Colombia (COLFUTURO) and Deakin University share an interest in strengthening bilateral cooperation in the field of education between Colombia and Australia, promoting stronger ties between the two institutions to increase the administrative support and guidance available for English language studies of Colombian students.

The purpose of this agreement is to foster cooperation and enhance the links between the two institutions through the provision of shared administrative support for talented students admitted to the COLFUTURO Language Program (LP) at Deakin University English Language Institute (DUELI) held at the Melbourne Burwood Campus and the Geelong Waterfront Campus in Victoria, Australia.

The mutual cooperation will operate as follows:

- 1. Colombian students interested in learning or improving their English language skills will seek admission to the COLFUTURO Language Program. Once students have been admitted and decided they would like to study at DUELI, COLFUTURO will support them in their admissions processes to the English programs offered by university in reference, following the normal application procedures and meeting all the standard admission requirements (waiving the application fee) established by DUELI.
- 2. Students admitted to the Language Program of COLFUTURO are responsible for the attainment of financial resources to cover their programs.
- 3. COLFUTURO will receive the students' payments in three different instalments and then make the international wire of the total cost of their program (one payment in full) directly to the Deakin University DUELI account which will have been previously determined. COLFUTURO will pay on the students' behalf before their programs have started. Some students may decide to pay other costs such as accommodation, meals plans, etc. directly to the university.
- DUELI will invoice COLFUTURO directly for each of the students admitted. The invoices will be prepared separately for each of our individual students and will have a breakdown for every item.
- 5. DUELI will provide a partial scholarship thus resulting in a fee per week of AUD200 per student (equivalent to 55% of the list price for the Burwood Campus and 48% of the list price for the Geelong Campus in the value of tuition for open enrolment English program at DUELI to up to 10 students sent by the Language Program of COLFUTURO in each calendar year. This benefit will be maintained and/or extended for the time the student decides to study at DUELI.

- 6. DUELI will offer a full tuition scholarship to any open enrolment English program for every 10 students referred by COLFUTURO in the previous conditions mentioned.
- 7. COLFUTURO will provide administrative support and guidance to the students with their admissions and visa processes. COLFUTURO will promote DUELI open enrolment English programs at the university centres mentioned above and the benefits agreed to by this mutual cooperation.
- 8. Each institution will designate a coordinator to implement and monitor this agreement. In particular, the designated coordinators will be responsible for ensuring that:
 - a. DUELI and COLFUTURO provide prospective Colombian Language Program students with information on their programs of interest and guidance on how to apply to DUELI.
 - b. DUELI provides COLFUTURO with all the relevant promotional materials and brochures on the different English study programs offered by the universities mentioned to encourage interest among prospective Colombian students.
 - c. DUELI provides all Colombian students admitted to their English language programs information on the Language Program of COLFUTURO and encourages these students to contact and submit an application to COLFUTURO.
 - d. COLFUTURO informs DUELI of successful candidates by sending the list of Colombian students admitted to the Language Program of COLFUTURO. Furthermore, COLFUTURO will inform DUELI if students decide to postpone or withdraw from any programs.
 - e. Both institutions have the obligation to inform the other party of any change in the designated coordinator or signatory in charge of this agreement.

This agreement shall remain in force from the date of signature by the designated representatives of each party and may be reviewed or renegotiated at the request of either party. Either party may terminate the agreement by providing at least thirty days prior written notice to the other party.
